AN ORDINANCE

Amending Section 9-205 of The Philadelphia Code, relating to “Sidewalk Sales,” and vending in residential areas, within the Ninth District, by deleting a provision allowing sidewalk sales and vending in the area bordered by and including Olney avenue, Cheltenham avenue, Broad street, and Fifth street, both sides.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Section 9-205 of The Philadelphia Code, relating to Sidewalk Sales and vending, is amended to read as follows:

§9-205. Sidewalk Sales.

* * *

(8) Prohibited conduct. No person or vendor shall:

* * *

(p) exhibit, display, offer for sale or sell any goods, wares or merchandise or place or allow any stand to remain on the sidewalks of the following streets or any other location which Council shall from time to time ordain:

(.354) The area bordered by and including both sides of Olney avenue, Cheltenham avenue, Broad street and Fifth street[, except that sidewalk sales shall be permitted on the south side of Medary avenue from the southeast corner of Broad street to a point seventy feet east from the southeast corner of Broad street].
