AN ORDINANCE

Amending Chapter 9-600 of The Philadelphia Code (“Service and Other Businesses”) to provide for a requirement that convenience stores provide receipts to minors, all under certain terms and conditions.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PHILADELPHIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 9-600 of The Philadelphia Code is hereby amended by adding a new Section as follows:

TITLE 9. REGULATION OF BUSINESSES, TRADES AND PROFESSIONS

CHAPTER 9-600. SERVICE AND OTHER BUSINESSES

* * *

§ 9-633. *Convenience Store Receipts.*

(1) *Definitions.*

Convenience Store. Either of the following:

(i) *Any store that is primarily engaged in the retail sale of a limited line of goods that includes, but is not limited to, milk, bread, soda, and snacks.*

(ii) *Any store that sells automotive fuel, and also engages in the retail sale of a limited line of goods that includes, but is not limited to, milk, bread, soda, and snacks.*

Minor. Any person under the age of 18 years.

(2) *Receipts required. No Convenience Store shall make any sale to a Minor unless the Convenience Store provides a receipt to the Minor at the time of the sale. Such receipt shall, at a minimum, clearly set forth the following: the name and address of the Convenience Store, the date of sale, the quantity and cost of each item purchased, any applicable tax, and the total amount paid.*

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
